- 1st Jan Fletcher's **BALIROLYAT IMELDA MAYHEM**, 8yr old bitch, well presented and in good coat, lovely head and expression, well balanced body with lovely movement. **B.V.I.S.**

Angela Cooke's **STAR DU NEUFMOULIN FOR MONTELLE (Imp Bel)** - Lovely smart pup with great proportioned head and lovely length of neck, nice front with well placed shoulders, strong muscular hind quarters and lovely movement when settled, coat in great condition, another young dog I feel has a very promising future ahead of him. **B.P.I.S.**

CLASS 4 – JUNIOR DOG (2)

- 1st Mr B M & Mrs A J Atwell's **KERRYKEEL CONCHOBHAR AT XANWIL** very catching length of head with great reach of neck and well laid back shoulders, well boned hind quarters and structure with correct tail set, coat in lovely condition, settled well on the move, **B.I.S.**
- 2nd Mr Patrick McConnell's **TOOTROCK ARCTURUS** standard dog in good make and shape, nothing exaggerated, nice expression and well-set ears, coat in great condition, moved sound when settled. I felt a little extra height added in comparison to the breed standard, not as much reach in head and neck to 1.

CLASS 6 - POST GRADUATE DOG (1)

John & Jan Nevill's - **NORAKIM AN STORR AT ROSEMONELLE** - well balanced dog with sound movement, another with a lovely length in head, correct ear carriage and mouth, well placed shoulder with ideal length of back and tail set, sound movement.

- 1st Ms Joy Simons' **SAREDON RED BERRY -** well balanced dog with nice structure, correct ear use, lovely expression and correct mouth, lovely length in neck with appropriate length in back, coat in good condition with sound movement.
- 2nd Mr R & Mrs J Atkin's **GENGIS KHAN -** strong clean head, ear set and nice expression, good coat and presentation, positive in movement with good reach and drive, not as much reach in neck as 1.

CLASS 8 - OPEN DOG (1)

1st Carol Bamsey's - **HOLBAM CELTIC WIZARD JW** - a sound looking dog in excellent condition, correct head ear set and bite. Well angulated hind quarters with well set on tail and good top line, lovely movement. **R.B.D.**

CLASS 9 - PUPPY BITCH (2)

- 1st Mrs G Thomas' MONTELLE LIGHT THE WAY AT SUNNYSTONE Lovely feminine expression with nice length of head and neck, well balanced pup, movement a little erratic at first but soon settled and moved well, **B.P.B.**
- 2nd Ms S Brocklebank & Mr M Panting's **SIFELLY MIYA GOLD** Brocklebank, Sifelly Miya Gold, well presented puppy, nice head and ear set, well balanced body, a little more unsettled on the move than 1.

CLASS 10 - JUNIOR BITCH (2)

- 1st Carol Bamsey's **CARLIAMS WITCHING HOUR -** nice young bitch, well balanced throughout, neat well set ears giving pleasing expression. Good condition and coat moved with ease and well presented.
- 2nd Mr N Hamblin's **KENYTEN RUBY LAKE -** nice bitch, well presented with lovely ear carriage and correct mouth giving a pleasing expression. A little unsettled on the move compared to 1.

The first class was for dogs and owners who had not won a ticket or reserve ticket, the second class for dogs who had not won a reserve ticket or above, and the third class open to all.

CLASS 1 (8,0) - FOR HANDLER/OWNER OR DOG NOT HAVING WON AN RCC/CC

- 1st Simons' **SAREDON RED BERRY**. Stunning racy outline. Strong typically male head, excellent dentition, and typical dirty look for expression. Good ear placement. Good reach of neck to well laid shoulders, deep chest, excellent in overall balance and substance, moved well
- 2nd McConnell's TOOTROCK ARCTURUS. Good overall balance and substance, good head, dentition, and overall outline. Moved well in this class, however tended to throw a leg in the next class.

Clean front, good reach of neck to well laid shoulders, excellent in body substance and overall balance. Excellent rear angulation moved soundly.
- 2nd Ruffles & Williamson's **HOLBAM CELTIC ERIN**. Feminine head, lovely expression, gorgeous ears. Good in shoulder, deep chest, good rear angulation. Very good in overall outline and balance, moved soundly.

CLASS 3 (4.0) - OPEN TO ALL

Very strong in head and dentition, good ear placement which he used well, good reach of neck to well laid shoulders, racy outline excellent in rear angulation, in fantastic coat condition. Moved well with reach and drive.

Excellent in head and dentition, good placement and carriage of ears, good reach of neck to well laid shoulders, clean front, excellent racy outline, in excellent proportion and balance, excellent in rear angulation, moved soundly. Was a very difficult decision.
